If you choose not to use OE Tracker, you can still mail your paper certificates to the Board office.

Renewal information for 2015 will be mailed out around November 1, 2014. Some reminders:

- To expedite your renewal, please remember to answer the questions on the back of the application AND sign. Failure to do so results in the application being returned to you and a delay in receiving your new renewal card.
- If you choose to send in several renewal applications with one check and one of the applications is incomplete, all applications will be returned.
- If you use online banking, please send your completed renewal application to the Board with a note that you are using online banking and your check will be mailed separately.
