

You are receiving this message pursuant to the requirements of EO 2011-01K and Senate Bill 2 of the 129th General Assembly, which requires state agencies, including the Ohio State Board of Optometry, to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by SB2), and provide opportunity for the affected public to provide input on the rules.

The State Board of Optometry Administrative Rules require a review every five (5) years and if there are any amendments, rescissions, or no-change rules that impact business, public comments are welcomed prior to the rules being filed.
